AK SPCA teams with Anchorage Animal Care & Control Center to help cats

Some cats relinquished at [Anchorage Animal Care & Control Center](#) have been together for a long time. When separated at animal control, they can be adopted separately, or become stressed, sick, and possibly euthanized. To help encourage the adoption of long-time pairs of cats together, SPCA will pay the adoption fee for one of the cats when they both go to the same home.
