The Alaskan legislature is considering THREE animal-related bills: [HB 138](#), which strengthens the animal-cruelty statute, [HB 6](#), which defines bestiality as an act of animal cruelty, and [S 214](#) that make egregious acts of animal cruelty a felony on the first offense rather than the third.
