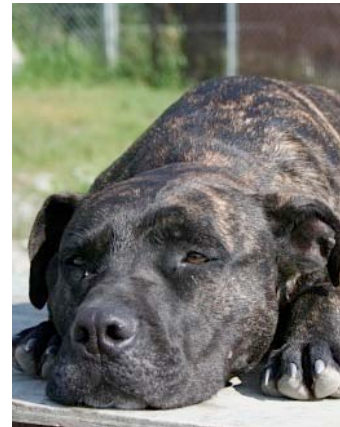
Alaskan anti-cruelty bills need your support
